Bed Bug Help

Bed bugs are becoming a bigger problem. They can be carried into your home by luggage, bedding, or furniture. To help prevent infestation, make sure you

wash luggage and clothing immediately after returning from a trip and inspect used furniture before bringing it into your home. Never bring discarded bed frames, mattresses, box springs, or upholstered furniture into your home. Make sure to clean your bedding and furniture regularly. If you think you have bed bugs, call the office immediately!! The longer you wait to report them, the harder and more expensive the task to get rid of them. Please don't be embarrassed. If you fail to tell us, the cost for the extermination will increase. Any questions, call us NOW. More information coming to our website soon.

The Newark Housing Authority knows that you want to make your house/apartment your "home". One way to do this is to add your "special touch" with paint. Although we like you



sprucing things up and making your unit more beautiful, we discourage you from painting as you will be required to restore the walls/ceiling back to original state prior to move out at your expense. If maintenance has to repaint after move out, this charge will be deducted from your security deposit.
