Snow Removal

Maintenance will begin plowing at approximately 5:30 am if we receive <u>3 inches of snow or more.</u> Please be extra cautious around the snow plows. <u>Just because you see them</u> <u>doesn't mean they see you.</u>

Don't expect immediate results during times of heavy snowfall (6" or more). Be patient and don't call the office!

Driving Park Circle Tenants...

During periods of heavy snow, be sure to keep the snow clear around the furnace ventilation pipes (white PVC pipes) that are located behind your house.

Failure to keep these clear of snow can result in your furnace not working.

Food Boxes: Online registration for holiday food boxes starts December 10th. Limit one food box per household. Identification with a Wayne County address is required. Pick up the food boxes December 18th at 12 Geneva St., Lyons. For more information, call 315-690-1952.

Identification with a Wayne County address is required as is proof of custody or birth certificate for each child. Northview & Windsong Terrace Tenants...

Do not place electrical appliances such as TV's and electric heaters near your thermostat or block your thermostat with large furniture. These items trick the thermostat into thinking the temperature of the room is different than what it really is, not allowing your heater to work properly.

Are Your Windows Closed?

Good-bye to bare feet, shorts and tank tops...hello sweat shirts, pants and heavy socks! Cold weather is here!!! To ensure the heat stays in your unit, check to make sure your windows are closed and locked. A reminder to <u>Windsong Terrace</u> tenants who do not have electric heat...<u>DO NOT</u> turn your heat down when you leave your house. Your heat is generated from a boiler system which takes several hours to bring the temperature back up after being turned down.

<u>**HEAP</u>**—If you pay your own heat, you may be eligible for HEAP assistance. If you receive food stamps or social security, you most likely qualify for HEAP assistance. Call Wayne County Department of Social Services at (315) 946-4881 for more information.</u>

Mold Reminder

Mold can be a serious problem and cause harm to you and your family.

You can get rid of mold by spraying the areas with Lysol, white vinegar or a solution of 1 teaspoon baking soda combined with 2 cups water. Let it dry naturally. You can also use any over the counter mold/mildew cleaner. <u>Do not use bleach.</u>
