What is an Emergency?



When you call the emergency number, please remember it is only for emergencies. What is an emergen-

cy? A gas leak, an electrical problem, any security issues such as broken window or door, a constant water leak or sewer back up are examples of emergencies. A lock out is also something that can be called in, but there is a charge. If maintenance gets called out for anything that is not an emergency. there will be a 2 hour call out charge passed on to you.

Reminder to Driving Park Circle

Tenants...this cellar is NOT acceptable. It must be kept clean. Don't risk eviction over poor housekeeping.



Plugged Sewer...

Recently we have had calls for plugged sewers which were caused by tenant neglect (tenants flushing things down the toilet that are not biodegradable such as baby wipes, sanitary products and other various items). Please make your family aware of what should and should not be flushed down the toilet. If maintenance finds the clog is due to tenant neglect, you will be charged.

Moving Out?

First, if you plan on moving out it is important to give the office a 30 Day Notice. This means that you need to tell us 30 days prior to the date that you plan on being out of your unit. Secondly, you need to think about your security deposit. Security deposits are required to be returned to you within 30 days of your move out date. However, the amount returned is less your final water bill, charges and/or cleanup. Anything left in the unit (furniture or garbage) that must be removed by maintenance will be subtracted from your security deposit. Any cleaning of the unit or appliances will also result in a charge. The more effort you make to clean your unit before you move will result in a bigger security deposit refund.

Money Order Prices:
