Attention Windsong Terrace Tenants...

Some of the houses at Windsong Terrace are heated with a boiler system. This means that their heat is generated by extremely hot water running through baseboards located throughout the unit. This hot water tends to create excess moisture which could potentially cause mold to appear on interior walls and ceilings. To help avoid this problem, be sure that your furniture is pulled away from the heat runs, allowing for appropriate air flow throughout your house.


FoodLink Curbside Market Dates
