MOWING.....

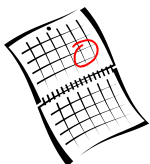
It is your responsibility to keep your yard mowed, trimmed and clean on a regular basis. Village of Newark Code Enforcement Office states that grass/weeds above 6" tall is a violation. We will not tolerate any lawn that is cluttered or full of debris or garbage. **Be aware, if the maintenance department is mowing and sees that your lawn has not been mowed and is high, they will mow it and you WILL BE CHARGED \$75.00.**

Your yard is for lawn furniture, **not vehicles**—please do not park your cars there. You will be charged for any damage done to your yard!!

Windsong Terrace residents...be sure garbage and trash is placed in the dumpsters and not left on the ground.
