Plumbing Care

Never pour cooking oil or other greasy materials down the drains. Oils and grease used in cooking may be liquid after use, but they can harden inside pipes and cause blockages. Instead of pouring grease down the drain, wipe it off the pot or pan with a paper towel, place a slice of bread in it to soak the grease up and throw it away or pour cooled oil and fats into a non-recyclable container and then dispose with the trash.

Avoid putting feminine products and baby wipes down the toilet. They will not only plug your toilet but also plug the sewer line.

Please make your family aware of what should and should not be put down the drain. If maintenance finds the clog is due to tenant neglect, you will be charged.

No More Flat Rents

As you are aware, we will be converting to RAD effective October 1st. If you were a flat rent, you were used to not having to report your changes in income. With the conversion to RAD, there is no more flat/ceiling rent. Therefore, <u>ALL</u> tenants will have to report <u>ALL</u> changes in income in writing within 10 days of the change.
